And Elijah came unto all the people, and said, How long halt ye between two opinions? if the Lord be God, follow him: but if Baal, then follow him. 1 Kings 18:21

This is what Elijah said on Mt. Carmel prior to God sending supernatural fire to consume the sacrifice.

He did this with Jacob when God met Jacob at Bethel and spoke to him about the promised seed. Jacob vowed that if God would be with him and bring him back home safely, that He would serve the Lord with all of his heart. We need to live this way in our walk with God. Believe what He said and do what He says and live with no more excuses!
