Give Glory to God

As servants of the One God who is holy, righteous, allwise, and all-powerful creator of the universe, we must reject all explanations of satan's origin, power, and activity that contradicts God's revelation of Himself in His Word. I believe when we understand who God is, it sheds greater light on who satan CANNOT be. We must start with a firm understanding of God, knowing that He is omnipotent, all-powerful, and sovereign over the entire universe. We have to start with a foundational understanding of who God is and His nature as we try to understand the one who is opposed to His glory in our lives. The reality that creation was a part of God's plan and design is fundamental to understanding Christianity.

God made man in His own image which included the capacity of free will. Loving and serving God would be meaningless if it were not a choice, and we had no other alternative.

Apparently angels, as heavenly spiritual beings created to serve and worship God, have this same choice. Satan is a fallen angel who coveted God's glory and chose to rebel against God's authority.

The reference in Isaiah 14:12-14 is an analogy of this event. Ezekiel 28 and Revelation have similar references, but notice the arrogance that characterizes his nature. "I will ascend. I will be exalted. I will be like the Most High."

We need to understand that blatant immoral evil is no worse than a self-centered life.

All rebellion against God and living for self deprives God of His glory and is contrary to His will. The exaltation of self and disobedience characterize satan. We can see that this is the nature of flesh in the battle between the flesh and the Spirit. Flesh is not just blatant sin and immorality, it is essentially a self-centered life living for self instead of God. Because of his rebellion, satan was rejected from heaven and this was the beginning of **spiritual warfare**.

The words of Jesus in Luke 10:18 refer to this event prior to the foundation of the world. "I beheld satan as lightening fall from heaven." I am convinced that God knew the consequences that would follow when satan was cast out of heaven.

He knew the temptation that satan would bring to man. He foresaw the evil and conflict that would be instigated and stirred up in the world. God was fully aware of the continual warfare to which we would be subjected, but even before the foundation of the world, redemption was planned and victory was assured as a daily reality to those who were in Christ.
